Preparing Your Quilt for Professional Quilting Services

At Sewcial Creatives, we're committed to delivering the highest quality quilting results. To help us provide the best possible service and ensure a smooth process, please follow these important preparation guidelines:

1. Backing and Batting Requirements

- Your backing and batting must extend 4" beyond the quilt top on all four sides.
- These layers must be in a single piece.
- Example: For a 100" x 100" quilt, prepare backing and batting measuring 108" x 108".
- Note: Additional charges may apply if we need to piece together your backing or batting.

2. Remove Hard Objects

- Carefully inspect your quilt and remove:
 - Pins
 - Buttons
 - Zippers
 - Snaps
- Any other hard objects that could interfere with the quilting process

3. Thread Management

- Clip all loose threads before dropping off your quilt.
- Loose threads can significantly impact the final quilting result and complicate our workflow.
- Take time to carefully trim threads for a clean, professional appearance.

4. Quilt Squaring

- Ensure your quilt has:
 - 90-degree corners
 - Straight, even edges
- Proper squaring is crucial for achieving a straight, professional finish.

5. Binding Fabric

- If you want us to bind your quilt, please provide the specific fabric you'd like us to use.
- Bring the binding fabric along with your quilt top.
